# THIS YEAR IT'S ABOUT THE SAINTS -Fr. Michael Arbanas

January church bulletins tend to focus on the New Year and the opportunities it creates to re-dedicate our lives to the Christian path of repentance, worship, prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The fact that we commemorate Jesus' Baptism on January 6 adds extra incentive to renew our focus on repentance, worship, prayer and fasting.

All this is absolutely appropriate, and we continue to encourage it.

This year, though, we're going to concentrate on the rest of the month, filled as it is with the feast days of many inspiring saints - people who have shown us, over the centuries, how to live out our baptisms and follow Christ.

Here are a few of the commemorations this month:

- St. Anthony the Great (Jan. 17, 3rd Century) recognized as the "Father of Monasticism" in both the East and West.
- St. Maximos the Confessor (Jan. 21, 7th Century) who struggled against heresy so eloquently that the heretical Emperor had his tongue uprooted and right hand cut off so Maximos could no longer preach or write against it. He died in exile.
- St. Timothy the Apostle (Jan. 22, 1st Century) an early and faithful disciple of St. Paul who later became the first bishop of Ephesus and died as a martyr in the year 97. Paul's two Epistles to Timothy are addressed to him.
- St. Ephraim the Syrian (Jan 28, 4th century) the first person to make they poetic expression of hymns into a way to express Orthodox theological teachings, known to many as the first and greatest hymnographer of the Church.
- The Three Holy Hierarchs Basil the Great, Gregory the Theologian and John Chrysostom (Jan. 30, 4th and 5th centuries) - the "Great Hierarchs and Ecumenical Teachers" who explained the Holy Trinity, defended the faith in the face of heresies, lived according to the monastic example and preached the Gospel eloquently. (St. Gregory is also commemorated on Jan. 25.)
- Sts. Cyrus and John, the Unmercenary Healers (Jan. 31, 3rd Century) men of prayer who healed illnesses in Christ's name freely and without charge, and who were martyred for their faith.

All of these saints, in different ways, showed the Light of Christ in the way they lived, and at the center of their lives was a deep love of God expressed in worship, prayer, fasting and care for those in need.

We, too, have this calling - to live by faith in the Lord in all things, every day of the week. The details will be different for each of us, but the foundation is the same for all – walking in the way of Christ. May God bless us all to stay on this path for the year ahead and for the rest of our lives.



In an effort to communicate the status of our loan for the St. Nicholas Family Life Center & renovations to St. Nicholas Church, below is a condensed timeline to recap the past 20 years.

1999: Purchased 10 acres in Town & Country for \$2,500,000

2003: Retired the land loan for a total of \$3,200,000

2010: First St. Nicholas Capital Campaign raised \$4,000,000 in pledges and construction began on the St. Nicholas Family Life Center as well as the renovations at St. Nicholas at Forest Park

Total cost to complete construction of the St. Nicholas Family Life Center and major renovations to St. Nicholas Church on Forest Park of \$8,500,000

2012: Signed loan documents for \$5,855,024

2015: Refinanced to a lower 3% interest municipal bond loan of \$5,273,184

- 2020: Extended our current municipal bond loan for 5 years at the same 3% interest rate and continuing the same amortization schedule
- 2024: As of November 5 our current loan amount is \$660, 028.83. Our monthly mortgage payment is \$25,500

We have made significant strides towards paying off our debt. Thank you for your continued love and dedication to our Parish.


